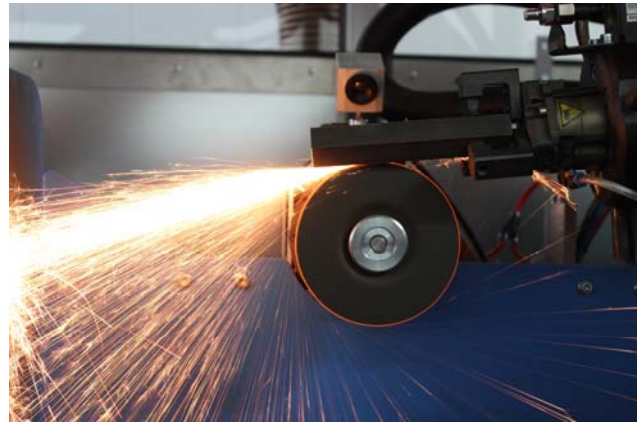
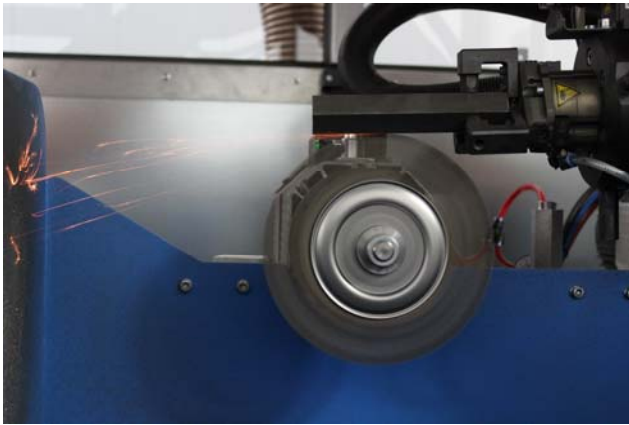
Brushes beat Abrasives

„Brushes beat Abrasives“ is Osborn’s motto at this year’s „Joining, Cutting, Surfacing“ in Essen/Germany from September 16th until September 21st. A live-demo directly at the booth (hall 11, booth B123) will inform the visitors why wire-brushes outmatch grinding discs in various applications.

As an undesirable by-product MIG-, MAG-, WIG- and manual welding create all sorts of debris on the surface of the work-piece. Silicates and Bluecolor debris on root- and fill layers are not easy to recognize. The welder needs to trust in the efficiency of his selected cleaning tool. Osborn wire-brushes are predestined to this kind of cleaning work. They are non-stock removing and leave the welded surface untouched while debris is being taken off completely layer by layer. Additional advantages: Brushes are less noisy and work nearly spark-free – two essential points when talking about working safety. Furthermore the surface of the work-piece will not heat up as strongly as when using a grinding disc.
